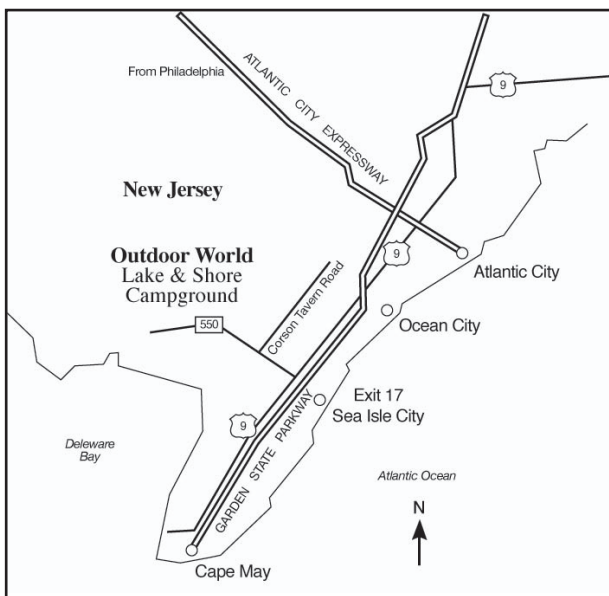

**GPS Coordinates:** N 39° 11' 38.88"  
 W 74° 43' 51.56"

**From the north:** Take Garden State Parkway south to Sea Isle City (Exit 17). Make left at stop sign; travel west 1/2 mile to Rt. 9. Turn right onto Rt. 9. Travel north on Rt. 9 (1/2 mile) to Rt. 550. Turn left onto Rt. 550 and follow to Corson Tavern Road. Make a right onto Corson Tavern Road and travel 1/4 mile to campground entrance on left.

**From the south:** Take I-95 through Baltimore to the Delaware Memorial Bridge. Take Rt. 40 east to County Rt. 557 south in Buena Vista. At Rt. 50 turn right. Follow Rt. 50 south, which connects into Rt. 9 south. Travel Rt. 9 south approximately one mile to Rt. 550 west. Turn right onto Rt. 550 to Corson Tavern Rd. Turn right onto Corson Tavern Rd. and travel 1/4 mile to campground entrance on left.

**From the north:** Take the Garden State Parkway south to Avalon, Exit 13. Turn right at exit and travel west 1/2 mile to Rt. 9. Turn left onto Rt. 9 and travel south for 1/4 mile to the campground entrance on right.

**From the south:** Take I-95 north through Baltimore to Delaware Memorial Bridge. Take Rt. 40 east to County Rt. 557 south in Buena Vista. At Rt. 50 turn right. Follow Rt. 50 south, which connects into Rt. 9 south. Travel approximately eight miles. The campground is 3/10 mile south of Avalon Entrance Road.

**From the north:** Take the Garden State Parkway south to Exit 48. Turn right onto US 9 and go 1/4 mile to CR-575. Turn right and go 200 yards to preserve entrance on the right.

**From the south:** Take the Garden State Parkway north to Exit 50 and loop back onto the Parkway going south. Take Exit 48 and turn right on onto US 9 and go 1/4 mile to CR-575. Turn right and go 200 yards to preserve entrance on the right.
