**Directions:**

**GPS Coordinates:** N 41° 43' 46.98" W 80° 49' 27.07"; elevation is 814 feet.  
**From the east or west:** Take I-90 to State Route 45 (Exit 223). Turn south and then left on State Route 307. Turn right on Foreman Rd., then left onto Mill Creek Rd. The preserve entrance will be on your left.  
**Notes:** There is a low-clearance bridge on Mill Creek Road between State Route 45 and Foreman. DO NOT follow GPS or Mapquest directions!

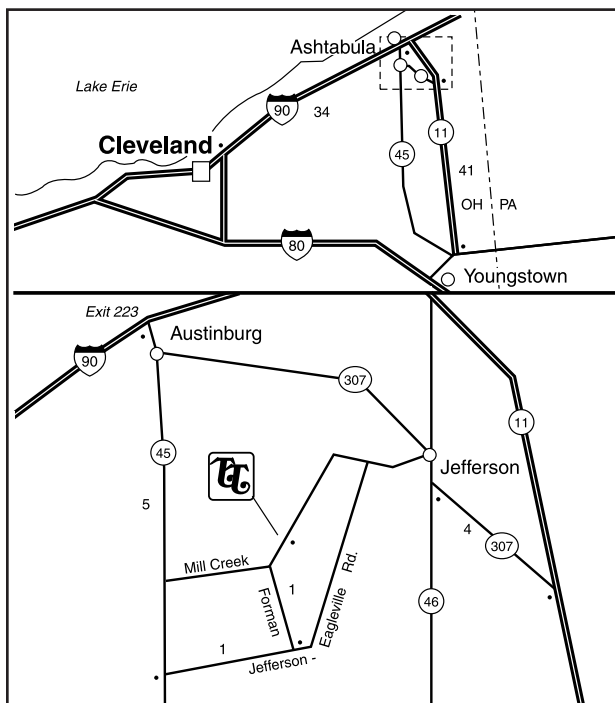

**T**his preserve features 170 acres of gently rolling land that surround a lake with good fishing and calm waters for canoeing (boats available). Eight miles away, the state parks of Cowan Lake and Caesar Creek offer fishing, boating, swimming and horseback riding. Local attractions include Kings Island Amusement Park and the Clinton County Historical Society's Museum in Wilmington.

### Accommodations

Campsites: 115 full hookups, 56 power and water only, 20 overflow sites, 3 pull-through sites; 30-amp electric. Rentals: 2 cabins, 2 trailers.

### Directions:

**GPS Coordinates:** N 39° 27' 32.88"  
 W 83° 56' 25.80"; elevation is 967 feet.

**From Cincinnati:** From I-71 northeast, take Hwy. 73 (Exit 45). Turn right and travel on Hwy. 73 for about 500 feet to Hwy. 380. Turn right on Hwy. 380, and travel south for about 1.5 miles. The preserve is on the left.

**From Dayton:** Travel south on I-75 to Hwy. 73. Follow Hwy. 73 southeast for about 20 miles to Hwy. 380. Turn right on Hwy. 380, and travel south for about 1.5 miles. The preserve is on the left.

**Alternative directions from Wilmington:** Take Route 22-3 west for about 6 miles to Route 380. Turn north (right) and drive about one mile to the preserve on the right.
